

## Fisher Catholic Parking Policy

1. **Every student** who is parked in the Fisher Catholic parking lot must have registered with Mrs. Spiegel and have an assigned parking spot. You will be given a parking tag after you have been registered.
2. You **must** have your parking tag visible in your rear view mirror at all times while parked in the Fisher Catholic parking lot.
3. If you are in a **different car** than the one that you have registered, you must put your parking tag in the car you are driving or let Mrs. Spiegel know that you are in a different car that day.
4. You must park in the spot that has been assigned to you. If someone else is in your spot when you arrive, you should park in a visitor's spot at the front of the school and see Mrs. Spiegel immediately. **Do not park in someone else's spot** thus causing a domino effect of wrong spots. If you have a license plate number and/or a tag number of the car that is in your spot, I can quickly look it up to see to whom it belongs.
5. If you get your license during the school year, you **must register your vehicle** with Mrs. Spiegel before you drive your car to school.
6. If you have any questions about parking, see Mrs. Spiegel in room 201.
7. Failure to follow these rules can result in a detention, a fine, and potentially the loss of parking privileges in the Fisher Catholic parking lot as outlined below.

### Consequences of parking violations:

1<sup>st</sup> offense: A written warning

2<sup>nd</sup> offense: A 45 minute after-school detention with Mrs. Spiegel and a write-up

3<sup>rd</sup> offense: Lose parking privileges in the Fisher Catholic parking lot for the remainder of the semester per Mrs. Wade

4<sup>th</sup> offense: Lose parking privileges in the Fisher Catholic parking lot for the remainder of the school year per Mrs. Wade
