

# Fisher Catholic Team Soccer Rules

1. Be conscientious in avoiding anything that in anyway, whenever or where ever, that in the judgment of the coaching staff is detrimental to the good of the team, the school, or to you. Consequences will be determined through the best discretion of the coaching staff,
2. All School Rules are Team Rules
3. The Fisher Catholic Alcohol, Drug, and Tobacco Policy will be strictly enforced. Violations will result in additional team penalties!
4. All injuries are to be reported to the coach immediately. Players who are injured will not return to practice without the consent of the trainer and their parents.
5. Players are not to be late or absent from a training session or team meeting without being excused by a coach prior to the training session or meeting. This means all equipment is on and player is set to go. Tardiness will result in loss of game playing time and additional running. Continued tardiness will result in suspension and if continued, eventual termination from the team.
6. Players are to be dressed appropriately for practice and **must wear shin guards**. If a player is required to wear a brace or any other type of protection, it must be worn in practices and games.
7. **No jewelry** is permitted to be worn at training sessions, games, and team meetings. This includes all body piercing!
8. Players will bring all playing equipment to all games and trainings sessions home and away. Players are responsible to provide their **own water & soccer ball at all practices and games**. No sharing of water will be permitted.
9. Foul language is not permitted
10. You represent Fisher Catholic High School; therefore, respect your team-mates, opponents, coaches, referees, teachers, parents, etc. at all times.
11. You are to respect and take care of the uniforms, equipment and facilities you use.
12. If a player has questions concerning playing time, discipline, or any other concern, she should address this with one of the coaches first. If the player is not satisfied with the explanation from the coach, a parent and the player then would be encouraged to discuss the situation with the coach.

We, the undersigned, have read the attached rules, understand these rules and agree to abide by all rules of the Fisher Catholic High School Soccer Program. We understand that violation of these rules could result in suspension or expulsion from the soccer program.
