

Fisher Catholic Parking Policy

1. Every student who is parked in the Fisher Catholic parking lot must have registered with the office and have an assigned parking spot. You will be given a parking sticker after you have been registered.
2. You must have your parking sticker visible at all times while parked in the Fisher Catholic parking lot.
3. If you are in a different car than the one that you have registered, you must notify the office.
4. You must park in the spot that has been assigned to you. If someone else is in your spot when you arrive, you should park at the visitor's spot at the front of the school and see the office immediately. Do **not** park in someone else's spot, thus causing a domino effect of wrong spots. If you have a license plate number and/or tag number of the car that is in your spot, the office can look it up quickly and see to whom it belongs.
5. If you get your license during the school year, you must register your vehicle in the office before you drive your car to school.
6. Failure to follow these rules can result in the following penalties:
 - a. 1st Offense: Written Warning
 - b. 2nd Offense: 45 Minute After School Detention and Write-Up
 - c. 3rd Offense: Lose parking privileges in the Fisher Catholic parking lot for the remainder of the semester
 - d. 4th Offense: Lose parking privileges in the Fisher Catholic parking lot for the remainder of the school year
